Since the contractors and State Highway Commission are doing such a good job of taking care of the road from Route 180 to the sign post, no action was taken on that part of the road at this time.
3. The next meeting of the Association be held May 4, 1969 at which time, a financial report will be read and arrangements made to upgrade each side of the road based on the existing returns.
